How Globalympics works:

- Study sheets/tests are available for grades K-5
- A volunteer coordinates parents to test students in their class. Parents must decide which day/month they will test students. The class parent in charge will contact the teacher to arrange schedule.
- Testing is twice a month
- Parent must sign in at office or with receptionist
- Parent quietly informs the teacher that they have arrived and are ready to test.
- The class packet contains participating child's level of achievement (student card) - Children do not need to test each week (only if they have studied and are ready); Children are encouraged to join at anytime during the year
- Child will test in hallway using quiet voices. Not all children will pass the quiz. It is meant to be challenging but FUN!
- Always be supportive and encouraging. If a student does not know the answer, review it with them and send home a study sheet in his/her folder for the next testing period.

Advancing to next Level

1. Congratulate child and fill out certificate in the class packet for the level he/she has achieved
2. Leave the certificate on top of the teacher's desk so she can praise and give recognition
3. Write a note with the student's name, level of achievement, and teacher's name. Post in office for end of day announcements
4. Quarterly group picture of successful level achiever published in hallway, PTO showcase
